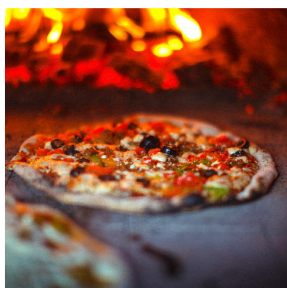

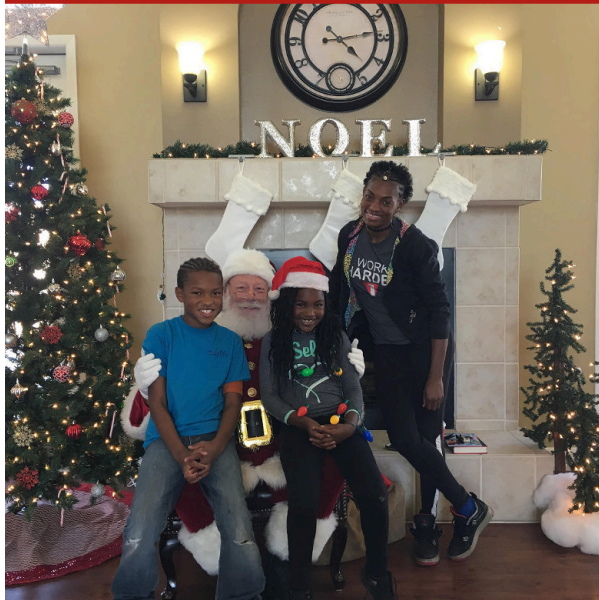

2018 - ORGANIZATION CORNER

START WITH THE HOLIDAY TRAPPINGS - To keep plastic ornaments and Hanukkah candles organized, use small containers you already have on hand, like popcorn and cookie tins or empty shoe boxes and egg cartons. Wrap fragile ornaments in leftover tissue paper or newspaper, or invest in storage containers. For strings of lights and garlands, use zip ties to avoid tangles and put them in plastic bags labeled according to use (tree lights, porch lights, balcony, bushes, etc.). Zip ties can also be used on wreaths, so that they can be hung on coat hangers and covered with plastic garment bags from the dry cleaner.
