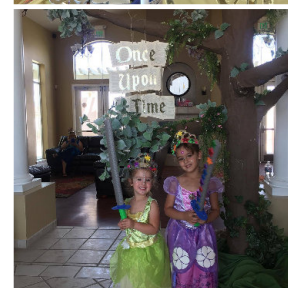


## FAIRY TALE DAY

## FOURTH OF JULY SAFETY TIPS

**SUN SAFETY:** Protect your skin against the sun with SPF, and drink plenty of fluids to avoid dehydration.

**WATER SAFETY:** Make sure everyone near water in pools, ponds, lakes, or the ocean has the proper skills to swim, keep an eye on young children and check floatation devices for leaks.

**GRILLING SAFETY:** Check to make sure your grill is in proper working order, don't ignite charcoal with gasoline or lighter fluid, use heat resistant tools and never lean over an open flame.

**FIREWORKS SAFETY:** Stay a safe distance away from any fireworks display. Be mindful of children with sparklers, as the wire remains hot enough to burn skin even after the sparks have ended. Please follow posted fireworks regulations.
