


extremely hot weather, and it is

with Blueberry-Balsamic Vinaigrette

Active: 30 mins Total: 30 mins Servings: 10

Ingredients

1 pound cherry tomatoes

3 (8 ounce) packages mini mozzarella balls

- 1 pint fresh blueberries, divided
- 4 ounces fresh mozzarella cheese
- 1/2 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 tablespoons white balsamic vinegar
- 1 tablespoon honey
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh shallot
- ¼ teaspoon kosher salt
- ¼ teaspoon ground pepper
- Fresh basil leaves for garnish



Trim the stem end off each tomato, so they sit flat on their cut sides Discard the ends or save for another use.

Step 2

Begin assembling an American flag by arranging one row of 10 tomatoes, cut-side down, on a large platter or cutting board. Arrange a row of 10 mozzarella balls directly below the tomatoes, and repeat with another row of tomatoes, another row of mozzarella balls, and another row of tomatoes. On the third row of mozzarella balls, add 5 more to extend the row to the left. Repeat with tomatoes and mozzarella balls two more times, ending with tomatoes.

Step 3

Set aside 1/4 cup blueberries. Arrange the remaining blueberries in a square to the right of the shorter rows of tomatoes and mozzarella

Step 4

Slice mozzarella into 4 pieces, then cut each piece into quarters. Using a paring knife, cut a star from each quarter, creating 16 stars total. (Alternatively, use a small star cookie cutter.) Gently arrange the mozzarella stars on top of the blueberries.

Step 5

Combine the reserved 1/4 cup blueberries, oil, vinegar, honey, shallot, salt and pepper in a blender; blend until smooth. Scatter basil leaves around the flag, if desired, and serve with the dressing on the side.

Routine Maintenance Requests through the Hunt Resident App or Online Portal

> Service Requests submitted through the Portal or App, are ONLY for Routine Maintenance Requests.

- These are Maintenance requests that are *not* a potential threat to life, health, or safety. Examples Include:
 - o Air Filters
 - Blind Repair
 - Cabinet Repair
 - Flooring Repair
- o HVAC Not Cooling Your Home
- Mailbox Repair
- Routine Pest Control Requests
- Toilet Seat Repairs

> For Urgent or Emergency Maintenance

Please call your Maintenance Service Request Line, 24 Hours a day to reach our team directly.

DO NOT Submit These Requests Through the Online Portal or Mobile Application

- Urgent or Emergency Maintenance may be defined as, but not limited to:
 - o Appliances that are Inoperable
 - Clogged Toilets
 - o Door Security
 - o Gas Concerns
 - o Leaks/Water Intrusions
 - o Lock Outs/Key Issues
 - Mold Concerns
 - o No Power
 - o No Water
 - o Smoke Detector/CO Detector Chirping or Inoperable
 - Water Heater Concerns
 - o Any other work order that is a potential life, health, or safety concern

Work Order Submission Process:

- Open your Hunt Resident application or log into the online portal to submit a Routine Maintenance Service Request
- · Work Orders are time stamped and immediately logged in the property management software
- Residents receive email work order status notifications throughout the process of their request through to completion from cdr@yardi.com
- Resident receives automated online survey and phone call to ensure satisfaction from surveys@satisfacts.com upon work order completion
