Pest Control

We ask that residents call the office to set up pest control appointments, instead of putting a pest control work order in on the Hunt Portal; this will afford us the ability to schedule a date and time while we have you on the phone. With the colder weather, please keep your garage doors closed as much as possible; field mice will migrate to the warmer areas, which could be your house if the garage doors are left open. Please call us at 505-551-3855 to schedule your pest control service.

Pets

Please make sure all pets are registered with the Kirtland and Maxwell Leasing Offices. We will need vaccination records and a picture of the pet. It is required that you pick up after your pet.

It is Getting Cold Outside

As the colder weather approaches, please remember pets are susceptible to frostbite and hypothermia and should be kept inside in the cold weather. Longer–haired dogs such as huskies and German shepherds are bred for colder climates and are more tolerant of cold weather; NO pet should be left outside for long periods in below–freezing weather, though.

We want to make sure you and our on-call Maintenance have a great Thanksgiving Holiday! In preparation for that, we ask that you please test your oven and burners ahead of time to ensure they are in working condition. If not, please put in a work order as soon as possible, so we can get it taken care of prior to the holiday. We would hate for your Thanksgiving holiday to go awry due to your oven not working.

What NOT to put in your Garbage Disposal!

Ever wonder what you can and can't put in your garbage disposal? We are here to answer that question for you. In essence... if a baby cannot eat it, your garbage disposal cannot


eat it. Always run cold water when using your garbage disposal.

Things you can put down your garbage disposal:

- 1. Soup (without bones).
- 2. Vegetables (chopped, Without peels).
- 3. Yogurt and applesauce.
- 4. Fruits (finely Chopped, without pits or large seeds).
- 5. Soft or liquid fo ods! If it's soft enough for a baby, it is soft enough for your G/D.

What **NOT** to put in your garbage disposal:

- 1. Rice & Pasta Rice and other starchy grains absorb water and can create a massive clog.
- 2. Eggshells Eggshells will damage the impellers and cause a clog.
- 3. Coffee grounds Coffee grounds will clump together and block the drains.
- 4. Grease & Oil Never put grease in the G/D, as it accumulates in the pipes causing blocked drains.
- 5. Banana Peels Banana peels will damage the blades.
- 6. Potato Peels Potato peels are starchy and will create a clog.
- 7. Bones of any kind Bones will damage the grinding mechanisms.
- 8. Meat Chunks of chicken or beef get stuck in the pipes and leads to clogs.
- 9. Shrimp Shells Seafood shells damage the blades and leads to clogs.
- 10. Fibrous Vegetables & Fruit items like Celery tend to get tangled up in the blades.
- 11. Nuts & Seeds Nuts are too hard to be effectively ground by the G/D.
