Flashlights and a NOAA weather radio, with extra batteries List of phone numbers, insurance and medical information

- Extra chargers for cell phones
- Cash First aid kit
- Food and water for three days for each family member and pet

Medications, baby supplies

Blankets, jackets, hats, shoes, sleeping bags

- Vehicle emergency kit
- Plastic sheeting and duct tape
- Trash bags, baby wipes, hand sanitizer
