Maintenance

Grill Cleaning and Maintenance Tips
There's a lot of grilling weather ahead of us. Here are a few tips:

- Clean flame tamers using a wire brush to remove debris
- Clean burners with a wire brush paying particular attention to port areas where the gas comes out. Clean delicate ceramic burners by turning on for 10 minutes to burn off debris.
- Brush grates routinely with a dry wire grill brush with the burners turned off. For charcoal grills, sprinkle water on grill brush to steam clean the hot grate.
- Inspect fuel lines on gas grills. Brush soapy water along connections. If bubbles form when gas is turned on, tighten connections or replace lines.
- Clean lids with dishwashing liquid and water. Dry with paper towels.
- Keep kids and pets away from grills. Adult supervision required!
- Store LP tanks upright in a secure area, not in vehicles.
- Ensure lid is OPEN when lighting a gas grill.Don't grill near structures, overhangs, fences or trees.
